What's Happening in GATE Pull-Out This Year?

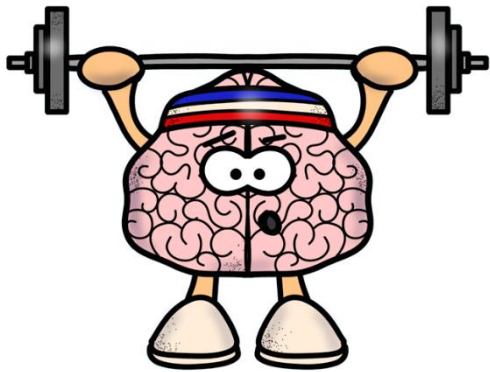

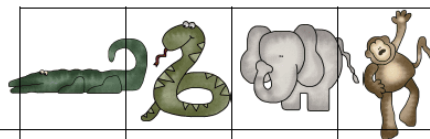


Logic Puzzles
